### BE THE MIGHTY... UNLEASHED!

If you want a true action-packed picture of what "unleashed" looks like, check out David's Mighty Men in the Bible. If there was a last man standing, it would be one of them! These three have amazing stories, and within each one is a lesson on how we too can be the mighty... unleashed!

The leader of this trio of trouble was a guy named Josheb-Basshebeth. Get this: he was in a battle one time, and took down eight hundred Philistines with just one spear! Yet consider this: with all this skill, talent and ferocity, he didn't hesitate to stop, submit to others and serve his future king. When David wanted a drink of water from a well in Bethlehem, Josheb-Basshebeth led his two fighting buddies all the way there, battling their way past Philistines just to get him a drink of water! Having skill and talent is one thing, but having a heart for serving others is something mighty indeed!

Eleazar was one of the three, with him on that trip. One day when the enemy soldiers rushed in, everyone pulled back. But not Eleazar! The Bible tells us he arose and attacked the Philistines until his hand was weary, and his hand stuck to the sword! We can be like Eleazar, because God has given us a weapon: His Word! Use God's Word to strike down those thoughts and temptations that come rushing in. Hold on to it so tightly that you can't let go, because you know something? God's Word makes you mighty!

The last of the three Mighty Men was a guy named Shammah. Just like Eleazar, he stood his ground and committed himself fully to defending God's kingdom. Everyone else fled, but Shammah actually held his ground, defending a field of beans from a surge of Philistine invaders! While others may talk of doing things for the church, it is only the mighty that actually do things for the church. A bean patch may have been a small thing to defend, but Shammah would not give an inch to that onslaught of Philistines! Like him, we too should hold our ground, and be committed to those things we stand up for. Do whatever it takes to win, big or small, because of this simple truth: being committed is what makes you mighty!

These three Mighty Men would tell you that being mighty is not all about spears, swords and defending bean patches. It's about service, holding tightly to what we believe, and committing ourselves fully to God's amazing plan for our lives. If you want to be mighty, remember these three, and remember their stories. Then you too can become the Mighty ... Unleashed!

Here are the names of David's mighty warriors.

Josheb-Basshebeth was chief of the three mighty warriors. He was a Tahkemonite. He used his spear against 800 men. He killed all of them at one time.

Next to him was Eleazar. He was one of the three mighty warriors. He was the son of Dodai, the Ahohite. Eleazar was with David at Pas Dammim. That's where Israel's army made fun of the Philistines who were gathered there for battle. Then the Israelites pulled back. But Eleazar stayed right where he was. He struck down the Philistines until his hand grew tired. But he still held on to his sword. The Lord helped him win a great battle that day. The troops returned to Eleazar. They came back to him only to take what they wanted from the dead bodies.

Next to him was Shammah, the son of Agee. Shammah was a Hararite. The Philistines gathered together at a place where there was a field full of lentils. Israel's troops ran away from the Philistines. But Shammah took his stand in the middle of the field. He didn't let the Philistines capture it. He struck them down. The Lord helped him win a great battle.

David was at the cave of Adullam. During harvest time, three of the 30 chief warriors came down to him there. A group of Philistines was camped in the Valley of Rephaim. At that time David was in his usual place of safety. Some Philistine troops were stationed at Bethlehem. David longed for a drink of water. He said, "I wish someone would get me water from the well near the gate of Bethlehem." So the three mighty warriors fought their way past the Philistine guards. They got some water from the well near the gate of Bethlehem. They took the water back to David. But David refused to drink it. Instead, he poured it out as a drink offering to the Lord. "Lord, I would never drink that water!" David said. "It stands for the blood of these men. They put their lives in danger by going to Bethlehem to get it." So David wouldn't drink it.

Those were some of the brave things the three mighty warriors did.

#### **HOW CAN YOU BE MIGHTY?**

God has a different way of seeing what "mighty" is. In 1 Samuel 16:7, it says, "The Lord does not look at the things people look at. People look at the outside of a person. But the Lord looks at what is in the heart."

It's not about muscles, armor, or action hero poses! It's about your heart. The Lord was saying that about scrawny David, who himself became a mighty man of God. King David would go on to do incredible things for the Kingdom of God!

**So... how can you be mighty?** It's all in your heart. It all starts with love for God, and for one another. Jesus told us in Mark 12:30-31 what was most important: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul. Love him with all your mind and with all your strength.' And here is the second one. 'Love your neighbor as you love yourself.' There is no commandment more important than these.'"

If you want to be mighty, the way to do it is simple. Love and serve God. Also love and serve others. You don't have to be like those mighty men who battled Philistines just to get King David a drink of water from a well in Bethlehem. But true mightiness starts with a good heart, and a willingness to serve others. That's how you become the mighty... unleashed!

#### THE SECRET PLACE

Do you really want to be unleashed? There is one place that you can find everything you need in life. It's where you find your power, your calling, and your destiny. It's where we all find our identity, which is who we are — and who we will be. It's all found in one place: our secret place.

But what exactly is the secret place? To find that answer, look throughout your Bible and see for yourself where the greats in God's Hall of Faith found their true identity.

It's clearest when we look at the life of Jesus himself, the King of kings. Right after Jesus fed more than 5,000 people with just two fish and five loaves of bread, and right before he walked on water across the Sea of Galilee, the Bible tells us exactly what Jesus did: "With the crowd dispersed, he climbed the mountain so he could be by himself and pray. He stayed there alone, late into the night." Matthew 14:23 (MSG)

We love to read about the miracles, and seeing the power of Jesus unleashed, but these in-between scriptures are just as crucial. They're important, because that's where Jesus found his purpose, his identity, and his power. And that's where you'll find it too: in the secret place.

When you spend time alone with your Heavenly Father, you'll be empowered with purpose, guidance, and everything you need in life to become what this world needs. When you spend time alone in worship, in His word, and in prayer, you'll become ... unleashed!
