
What you hold in your hand is an incredible resource, a tool designed to help us effectively partner with parents and lead children into a growing relationship with God.



### "FAILURE IS NOT AN OPTION"

"Houston, we have a problem." The astronauts of Apollo 13 were deep in space, and deep in trouble. One moment they were floating along on a routine mission. The next moment, their liquid oxygen tank exploded, shooting a 13-foot panel of their spacecraft out into deep space. And just like that, the astronauts were wondering if they'd ever get home again.

Fortunately, there were a few key things that helped bring them home: one was communication with Mission Control, and the other thing were the years of training each astronaut went through to get to this point.

Like astronauts, in our lives, one thing that is especially important is keeping the communication lines open – with God. We can't survive if we don't pray often. The Bible tells us to pray without ceasing. Could you imagine the astronauts making it back home without the help from Mission Control? Just the same, we can't float through life without talking with our Heavenly Father!

And don't think you're here just taking up space. Astronauts are always in training, and always ready for many situations that could happen. As Christians, we need to be ready in all seasons. Study to show yourself approved, worship with other believers and be alert at all times. You'll never know when you'll have to spring into action!

Just remember that it's all about getting home. In 1961, astronaut Scott Carpenter fired his retros just three seconds late when heading back into the earth's atmosphere. He missed the small window, and wound up splashing down 250 miles away from where he was supposed to land!

Our way home is a narrow path. The Bible tells us that the way to heaven is a narrow gate, one that could be easy to miss if you're not careful. That's why it's so important to pray, and stay ready at all times. Don't burn up on reentry – make sure you find that narrow path that leads us all back home.





## "ALL SYSTEMS GO"

One of the first times we heard him say it was to a blind man. "Go," said Jesus. "Your faith has healed you. "Like that man Jesus was speaking to, we all were once blind, stumbling around in darkness. But with His light of the world, now we can see clearly! We didn't do anything to deserve salvation and hope, but God gave it to each of us anyway. So go: our faith in Him has saved us, and given us help, healing and hope.

But Jesus wasn't done telling us to go. Early in his ministry, Jesus stopped the Pharisees from throwing stones at a woman – their aim was to punish her for sinning. But he stopped them short when he asked, "Has any one of you not sinned? Then you be the first to throw a stone at her."

Stones were dropped left and right. Jesus knew it very well: nobody is without sin. And yet his next command for us was a simple one: "Go, and sin no more." He'll forgive us when we ask, but we simply must turn away from doing those things that God isn't pleased with.

How fitting that he ended his ministry with one final "Go." Once the people there were healed and turned from their sins, there was one final mission from Jesus: "Go into all the world. Preach the good news to everyone."

This is our mission too: Go into all the world! You've been given a gift, one that God wants shared with the world. It is our Great Commission, and God's great hope that all the world can have everlasting life!

So get ready for action, and get ready to go: Go, because your faith has healed you. Go, and sin no more. And go into all the world and preach the good news to everyone. All systems go!

The Great Commission from Jesus is something he's asking all of us to do: Go into all the world. Preach the good news to everyone."




Cut out the shapes, and then fold along dotted lines.




Insert rocker flames, then tape or glue them in place.
